

Greenhithe School International Student Fees

We offer both short term and long term school placements.

Children under 10 years must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.



- ★ Full time academic study: \$13,200 per year + GST (15%), plus a termly activity fee of \$30.
- ★ Short term study: \$330 per week + GST

Additional Fees:

- ★ School registration: \$300
- ★ Math & English online programmes: \$80
- ★ Uniform

Fees include books, stationery and welfare support 7 days a week. Our school uniform must be worn, available from our online school uniform shop: Uniform@Greenhithe

What you can expect

New Zealand has an excellent education system and the people are friendly and welcoming towards international students. It is full of amazing scenery - mountains, beaches, lakes and national parks.

At Greenhithe School we offer international students a choice of short term or long term placements. Our ESOL teachers will help students enrol before they come to New Zealand. Whilst your child is here, we will help students to:

- ★ enjoy living with homestay families by providing support for students 7 days a week;
- ★ stay safe by supporting students with health and welfare issues;
- ★ improve their English; and
- ★ have fun by arranging activities and trips to great places in New Zealand.



Greenhithe School Refund Conditions and Procedures



All applications for a refund must be in writing to the Principal.

If the student has enrolled but has not yet started the course:

- Students must notify the school at least two weeks prior to their course commencing that they do not intend to start their course. The tuition fees may then be refunded in full, less \$800 cancellation fee.
- Withdrawing or transferring to another school without notification, may incur an additional penalty.
- School registration fee confirming placement at Greenhithe School is non-refundable.

If the student has started the course and is still in the first half of the course, the tuition fee may be refunded less the following charges:

- A cancellation fee of \$800;
- The cost of the course up to the end of the current term;
- Government charges that apply;
- Any commission that has been paid.

If the student has started the course and is in the second half of that course, the tuition fees may only be refunded if there are special reasons for the student leaving such as becoming seriously ill or a serious illness in the student's family or some other special reason. Refunds will be determined in the same manner as above.

If a refund is to be claimed, the parent of the student must:

- Write a letter explaining the special reason(s);
- Supply a medical certificate if deemed necessary by the Principal.

The Principal will make the final decision regarding a refund in these circumstances. There are NO refunds if the student has been asked to leave the school because of bad behaviour, poor attendance or because the student has broken the school's rules.

No refund will be made to an International Student who changes visa status to one which entitles them to domestic status.

No refund will be made to an International Student who fails to disclose relevant information or provides false or misleading information during any part of the enrolment process.

No refund will be made to an International Student who withdraws or transfers to another school.
