- All lessons are during school time and are 30 minutes in duration.

There is NO REGISTRATION FEE!

Prices range from \$18.40 per student per lesson for small groups to \$38 per student for 1-on-1 lessons.

Frequently Asked Questions from Parents

Do we pay per lesson?

Payment is made for the term - usually around 8 to 10 lessons and is invoiced before lessons start. Payment plans available.

Do we have to buy a musical instrument?

Guitar students are required to have their own guitars. Drum students are required to have their own drum sticks for home practice (drummers will not need a drum kit to start with).

Are there any other expenses?

A music tuition book is required for each student. Price range \$38 to \$45. These books typically last 1 to 2 years. The charge will be added to the first invoice.
