Thank you to those who filled out the survey for before school care. We had enough respondents to continue to explore offering the service at Greenhithe School. I am now working with a provider to examine cost, commitment level required and ensuring they have the capability and health and safety processes to run a great service for our community. I will be sending out further communication to those who responded positively in the next week or so.

Just a quick field update, we have been held up by the heavy rain of late, which has put a bit of a delay on the field being completed. Because of this, a decision was taken to postpone the installation of the gravel bands and sand dressing until such time as ground and weather conditions are conducive to achieving the desired result. An interim solution is underway and scheduled for the next week or so, involving mechanical decompaction/aeration of the field surface layer to allow surface water to drain into the previously installed lateral drains. It is hoped this solution will help to enable the use of the field during this term.

This term there are many awesome experiences for our children, such as trips, our art exhibition, sports tournaments as well as the amazing learning experience in the classroom that our teachers have been planning. The office has been busy with people paying activity fees for the term and also making school donations, we can't run all the events, experiences and give all the opportunities without your support, so a heartfelt thank you to those who have helped us out in this way so far this year. If the office is busy, remember these can be made online as well, I have included the details below.
