Key Competencies

This term our focus will be on the key competencies of thinking, managing-self, relating to others, participating and contributing and using language, symbols and texts. The students will be participating in a class rotation where they will practise these key competencies through different contexts, such as technology.

Literacy

One area that is a particular focus for the senior school, is the growth of vocabulary. Vocabulary knowledge is enormously important to children's development in reading and writing. During Year 5 and 6, students choose more precise words and phrases to suit the topic or purpose. Students are developing their ability to provide their audience with more detail and information using paragraphs, diagrams, pictures and captions.

Physical Education

During the first five weeks students will be working through an athletics rotation in preparation for Athletics Day in Week 5. They will be developing skills in order to participate in long jump, high jump, shot put, javelin, discus, and running/sprinting. We ask that children wear hats and appropriate footwear on the days that they are training.

Hats are required to be worn every day in Term 4. Please make sure your child has a school hat that is named.
