Enhancing Our Values- At Greenhithe School we have historically had our four houses of Te Wharau, Tauhinu, Pounamu and Wainoni, and they have been used for sports. To me this was a missed opportunity for children to learn the dispositions of teamwork, collective responsibility and the importance of being a part of something bigger than just themselves. Last year we had a competition to design house flags. The winning designs have been made into house posters, which are up in the hall. This week we have started to use our houses across all aspects of Greenhithe School life. The children are rewarded with house points for using our PRIDE values, which could be as simple as helping another child with their learning, inviting children into lunchtime games when they have no-one to play with and a multitude of other acts, which will help to reinforce the values we want our children at Greenhithe School to have and to help to prepare them as thoughtful, caring and responsible members of our local community. There will also be some inter-house competitions set up during the year too!

Each fortnight the houses in each house are ranked, the points from this added up and a winning house declared. The winning house will have their flag up on the flagpole under the New Zealand flag by the office. Each term, the house with the most points will be given a reward. The children are excited by the changes and I look forward to seeing our values enhanced through our school.

House Leaders

In line with the changes to the house system we have streamlined our student leadership system. Instead of having both house captains and school leaders, we have merged these into our new 'House Leaders'. There are six for each house and they will be involved in various activities and leadership work throughout the school. While this is a key role in the school, we also have many other leadership roles for the children to grow and develop their leadership skills, these include librarians, road patrollers, our Enterprise group and on the sports field.




