Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Mathematics

As we work through Term 4 please continue to support your child in mathematics as much as possible. There is plenty of shopping to be done for Christmas and the holidays, so this is a great opportunity to look at prices and discounts, there is a lot of learning out there. This term the teachers will be working hard on teaching number strategies to your child as well as covering and revising strand in mathematics, i.e. statistics, geometry and measurement.

Please keep encouraging your child to use Mathletics or any other mathematics website that promotes maths basic facts, especially multiplication and division.

Literacy

One area that is a particular focus for the senior school, is the growth of vocabulary. Vocabulary knowledge is enormously important to children's development in reading and writing. During Year 5 and 6, students choose more precise words and phrases to suit the topic or purpose. Students are developing their ability to provide their audience with more detail and information using paragraphs, diagrams, pictures and captions.

Physical Education

During the first five weeks students will be working through an athletics rotation in preparation for Athletics Day in Week 6. They will be developing skills in order to participate in long jump, high jump, shot put, javelin, discus, and running/sprinting. We ask that children wear hats and appropriate footwear on the days that they are training. This year we anticipate training to take place on Thursday and Friday.

Hats

Hats are required to be worn every day in Term 4. Please make sure your child has a school hat that is named.
