<u>Inquiry</u>

Our school-wide inquiry concept for this term is 'Sharing the Planet'. Our focus in Year 4 will be on 'How is nature protected?' The children have opted into inquiry groups that will focus on different areas of nature conservation, these include:

- Water oceans & freshwater
- Rainforests
- Endangered animals around the world
- Animals and habitats in New Zealand

As part of our inquiry, we will also be visiting Auckland Zoo on Tuesday 22nd June. We will provide more information about this trip later in the term.
