## Message from the Police

This morning we received a visit from the police following the police stop by our school. They told us that today they stopped a high proportion of parents of our school who were driving with no seatbelts on themselves or their children. They have asked us to reiterate the following messages to the community through the newsletter:

- It is the driver's responsibility for all occupants in the car to be wearing a seatbelt correctly at all times
- All children under the age of 7 should be strapped into a booster seat.
- Any child sitting in a booster seat should not be wearing a backpack on their back, as this is an unsafe position.

They have also informed us that they will be holding further regular stops in our area to check on compliance with the road laws.

# **Donations and Fees**

A massive thank you to those who have already been in to pay donations and activity contributions. These are so important to us and will allow our school to continue planning some developments for this year. Please remember these can now be paid **at either the office or online**. If you are in a position to make a donation, we really do appreciate them, as it does allow us to provide opportunities across the school. The donation suggested is \$200 per child and activity fee is \$35 per term.

The **donations** that we receive in 2022 will be more important to the school than ever. We are still unable to have international students, our fundraising in 2021 was severely impacted and we also receive less in general funding as a high decile school. This is why your donations are so important to the running of our school.

The requested **activity contribution** covers the trips, experiences and performers we have in schools. These trips and experiences are expensive and getting more so. Without parents contributing to these amazing experiences, they will not be able to go ahead. The reason we have a single payment per term is to stop the school having to request contributions of \$10 here and \$5 there for various trips, visiting performers and roadshows etc. Having one \$35 contribution per term seems to be a much easier way to manage it. This cost has also remained the same. Our teachers are committed to giving the children amazing experiences and even last term these continued.
