Quiz Night - Saturday 30th July

- Key Points / Agreed items:
 - New date for Term 3 Saturday 30th July
 - Sponsored by Aaron Aisher from Harcourts (and PTA member!!) is sponsoring the event
 - Quiz master with fully digital set up that does a 'school/charity' rate is now locked in
 - Auctioneer Shane Corteese
 - Sell as individual tables, up to 10 people per table. \$30 per person.
 - Auction Given length of evening, agreed to stick to a few high end prizes - 10 at most. Include a hamper - raffle tickets sold on the night.
 - BYO drinks/food. Each team to decorate own table in theme (choose your own) earlier in the day. Best dressed table/team prize.
