 Treasurer's report Tilly thanked Mel for aiding with Kindo navigation, set up, reconciliation etc. This past month we have had a number of fundraisers Quiz Night - over \$9k Raffle Calendar - over \$11k Pre-loved uniform sales - \$455 Junior Cross County - \$229.50 	Sjaan (on behal of Tilly)

-	 School paid out \$500 to sports uniform hire (separate account). PTA funded the uniforms and there was an agreement to charge a fee for their use so they can be replaced when needed. Sharon H-J (Sports Coordinator) has had feedback from parents and feels that we're charging too much for uniform hire. Can girls also wear a t-shirt rather than a dress? Gaynor to discuss with Sharon. Suggestion also to run through kindo. Over \$30k in the bank. Could transfer up to \$20k to School (need buffer for funding upcoming events). Michelle to tell us what it will be used for. Next fundraising item? Big ticket items - tables in the hall potentially. Electronic signs for outside of the school. Good way to communicate upcoming events. Would need to be further down Greenhithe Road. Stephen looking into it. 	
-	Media and comms - Followers on FB increased to 456 (up from 417 last month and up from 310 since the beginning of the year). 560 page views this month. Reminder that etap comms can be sent out separately to junior, middle and senior parents if required.	Mel
School - - - -	 update Michelle is the new teacher representative for Terms 3 and 4. Gave the go-ahead for Read-a-thon and Disco. Stephen's feedback was that he loved the Quiz Night. Michelle and Kelly have been visiting schools with large Asian communities, like Greenhithe School, and discussions have included fundraising. Feedback is Asian communities are very keen to support the school's fundraising efforts (often contributing large sums), but are less inclined to attend social events not linked to education. PTA to think about how it can reach and include more Asian families in the PTA/fundraising events. Reminder that we have Tong (teacher) who can send any comms in Mandarin via We-Chat. 	Michelle

Calenda - -	 Ar Raffle Fundraiser - August More than 50% calendars were sold - over \$11k brought in. A fantastic result, and a big thank-you to all those involved, particularly the school office staff who are in the process of handing out the prizes now. It was a great effort for the first year running, and the PTA can see lots of ways in which we can improve on the result for next year. Learnings/ideas for next time: Lots of stubbs weren't returned. Were parents given too many? Will ensure we don't hold over the school holiday period again. Next year look to give to local businesses to sell. Translation into mandarin. Need to reconcile eftpos/cash payments (will ensure this years winners have paid before they're announced on FB) Incentivise sales by giving a prize to the class who has sold the most tickets. Read-a - - -	 a-thon - 25 October To be held in the first two weeks of term 4. Launch week before end of the term. There will be a book character parade and the Scholastic Book Fair in the library. This will be organised through Raise-It. They provide a Campaign Manager, templates for comms etc. making organisation much easier. Every child is given a web portal, chooses their goals, and asks for sponsors. Closes Sunday after book week. Target is \$5k - conservative. Hauraki Primary did a spell-a-thon and it raised \$26k!!! Other schools with smaller rolls than Greenhithe have raised \$30k+ on similar events. 	Rebecca and Gaynor Marina keen to help out too
Quiz N - -	 light - Saturday 30th July Overall consensus was that the Quiz was a fantastic event which all who attended enjoyed. Raising over \$9k was a brilliant result. The games in particular were a very successful money earner. Learnings/do differents: Allow people to get money out through eftpos machine. Ended up with lots of coins which were difficult to count. Ability to purchase individual tickets, rather than only a full table. Idea to put 2-3 tables aside, individual tickets can be purchased for these tables on kindo.
